U13 Girls Table Tennis Team Win the West London Finals and now progress onto the London Finals in January, great work girls and good luck for January!

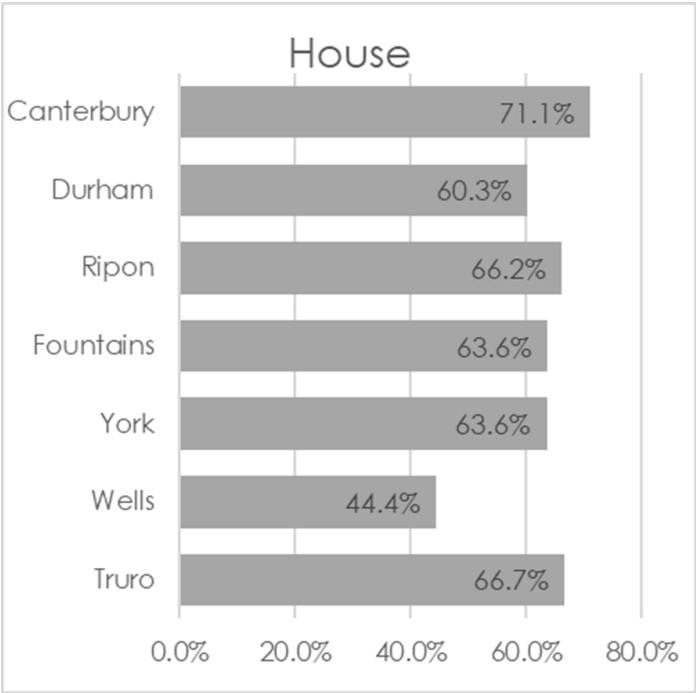
### Careers
