Course Selection

To start an A level programme of 3 A Levels you need to have at least 8 or more GCSE passes at Grade 5 equivalent or better, including Maths and English.

You should choose **one subject from each block in order of priority**. Each subject has its own entry requirements which will appear below the courses you select.

In some subjects students are set by ability and/or require a higher level of entry to ensure the right preparation for high level university courses.

Remember that **you can apply for any combination of subjects, providing that they are each in a different timetable block**, and that your GCSE grades match with the entrance requirements.
