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Entry Requirements

- To start an A Level programme of **3 A Levels** you need to pass **at least 8 GCSEs including** Maths and English with a grade 5 or better.
- To start an A Level programme of **4 A Levels** you need to pass **at least 8 GCSEs** including Maths and English with an average GCSE grade score of 7.5 or better (equivalent to roughly half of your grades at half 7/A and half 8/A).
- In some subjects students are set by ability and/or require a higher level of entry to ensure the right preparation for high level university courses.

Remember that you can apply for any combination of subjects, providing that they are each in a different timetable block, and that your GCSE grades match with the entrance requirements (See back page).
