The event explores careers in **coding, robotics, 3D print and design!**

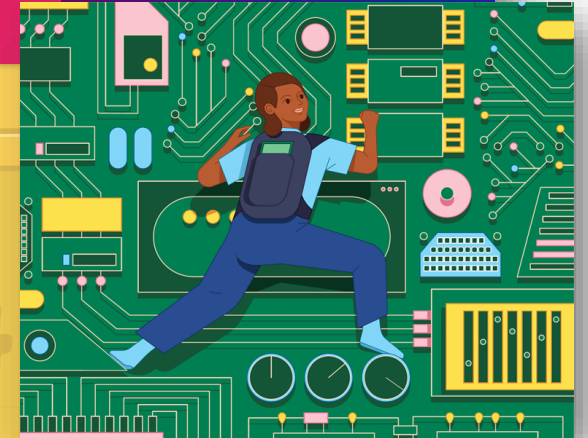
