

Year 7 Catch Up Premium 2019-20

The Year 7 Catch Up Premium is funding provided by the Department for Education to help raise the attainment of students who meet the criteria for the Year 7 catch-up premium. This is to support student progress in English and Maths at the start of secondary education.

In 2018-19 Twyford received £5,939.

In 2019-20 Twyford received £5,939.

The funding is allocated to support:

- Literacy booster lessons
- 1:1 reading
- Spelling groups
- Numeracy catch –up
- 36 students are benefitting from literacy intervention in Year 7 in 2020-21.

Last year the early intervention for literacy had a really effective impact on student achievement. The average rate of progress for the 42 Year 7 students needing literacy intervention was 2 years 7 months.

This funding has been subsumed into Covid catch up funding in 2020-21.
