Re: Year 7 Getting To Know You Day – Longridge

We have organised an outdoor education trip to Longridge Activity Centre for all Year 7 students. Due to capacity at the centre, the year group will be divided, with half the students going on **Monday 19**th **September** and the other half on **Tuesday 20**th **September 2022.** (You will be informed which day your child is attending in September).

The purpose of this trip is for pupils to get to know their new school friends and tutor, and to develop team-building skills and self-esteem through raft building and problem solving activities.

The arrangements are to arrive at school at the usual time of **8.00am** and return to school at **4.00-4.30pm.** Transport will be by coach and a kit list can be found on the back of this letter – please keep it safe. Pupils do not need to wear school uniform on this day.

The cost of the trip will be £44.00 and payments must be made through ParentPay by Friday 5th August 2022. You will only be able to do this after you have activated your new ParentPay account for William Perkin – we will send you details for this in due course.
