## Year 7 Catch Up Premium 2019-20

The Year 7 Catch Up Premium is funding provided by the Department for Education to help raise the attainment of students who meet the criteria for the Year 7 catch-up premium. This is to support student progress in English and Maths at the start of secondary education.

In 2018-19 William Perkin received £15,010.

In 2019-20 William Perkin received £15,154.

The funding is allocated to support:

• Literacy core elective lessons

Last year the early intervention for literacy had a really effective impact on student achievement. The average rate of progress for a Year 7 student needing literacy intervention was 2 years 2 months.

This funding has been subsumed into Covid catch up funding in 2020-21.
