The Child's promise to

- Always work hard and do their best
- Follow the school rules
- Respect others and be kind to them
- Encourage others
- Not be afraid to talk to an adult about a problem or concern
- Return any homework to school on time
- Respect and care for the school building, grounds and equipment

Parents and Carers Promise to

- **Ensure my child attends school regularly and arrives and is collected on time**
- **Ensure my child is wearing the correct uniform and has the correct kit and equipment**
- **Encourage a positive attitude to school work and homework**
- **Attend parent's evenings to discuss my child's progress**
- **Support my child with their learning and support the school's policies**
- **Encourage my child to respect other people and the school environment**
- **Not take holidays in school time unless under very exceptional circumstances**
