
Have a go at making a chick mask with your paper plate. You can use pencils, felt-tips, paint, small bits of paper or anything you may have at home.









Here are a few other ideas for you to try...

- Have a go at making a chick using playdough (a recipe is in your pack). Use
 a fork to make a pattern or use herbs to decorate. You can keep the
 playdough for at least a week if you keep it in an airtight container.
- If you can go outside, why don't you try and collect different materials to make a nest. Grass, sticks, leaves...what else could you find?
- Can you make the sound of a chick or a hen? Do they sound the same? Listen to the sound of a rooster, is that the same sound as a chick or hen?
- Imagine being a chick inside a shell. How tiny can you make yourself? Try finding a small space, such as under a table or bed or blanket. Could you create a nest using pillows, bed sheets, newspaper, odd bits of fabric and or blankets?
