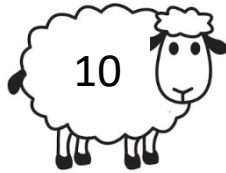
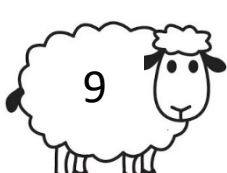
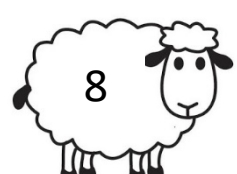
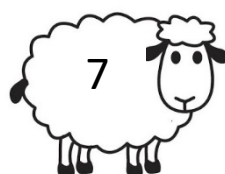
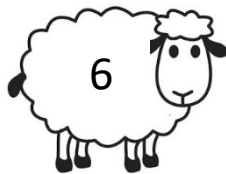
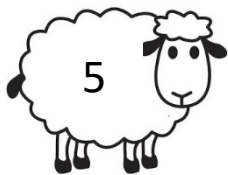
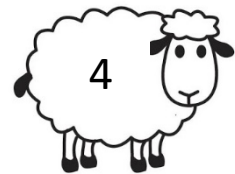
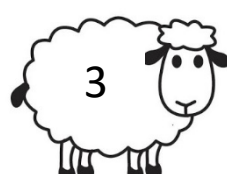
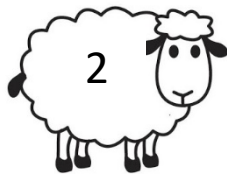
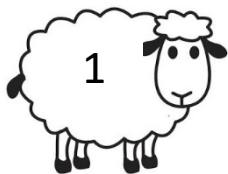


Little Bo Peep has lost her sheep,
