Dear Parents and Carers,

I know that life is starting to return to normal, and there are many more places that have opened up to us and hopefully more will continue to return to normal. However; it is important that you remember that we are not COVID free even if we have had the vaccination it can still be caught. The advice given to me as head of the school is that nothing has changed if you or your child has symptoms of COVID. These are a TEMPERATURE; Continuous COUGH; loss of TASTE or SMELL - you must self-isolate or take a test. If you do not want your child to have a test, then they will need to stay at home for 10 days. (We have learning packs that you may borrow for your child whilst they are at home.) Gentle reminder about some of the ways that we will work to stay safe and how you can help us with this:

<u>Masks;</u> We would ask that all adults wear a mask when they are on site, unless they are exempt.

<u>Adults on site</u>; We would like to limit the number of adults on site so only one person at a time to bring or collect the children, if it is possible please try to limit the number of different adults that come and collect the children.

<u>Social Distancing</u> Please remember that it is still important that you maintain SOCIAL DISTANCING when waiting to bring your child in, and to collect them.

<u>Settling new children</u> If you are new to the school, it is still important that we work together to settle your child. If you come in the classroom, please remember to wash your hands and to wear a mask.

<u>Crossing the white lines</u> White lines have been painted across the front of each classroom. Once your child is settled please do not cross the line. This will help us to all stay safe. We have worked very hard over the last year to keep everyone safe. We are very proud that we have only had one positive case of Covid-19 in our school community.

We are still maintaining all the cleaning and washing that is necessary between each session in order that we are all able to stay safe.

Tapestry

We have invested in a system called 'Tapestry', this is an online journal which helps us to record the children's learning. You will be asked to sign a form that you agree to this and you will have different options about what can be posted. We hope that this will be a way to increase the communication between us, as you can also post pictures about what has happened at home.
