Tapestry

During the last year we have been using a system called 'Tapestry' to keep you up to date with activities that your children have been doing in school. When the staff were having meetings with you at the end of last term, so many parents told us that they had not looked at Tapestry. The staff spend a lot of time ensuring that your child has regular photos and information published about what the children are doing it is a shame not to be able to see what they are doing. Some of the parent's share what their child has been doing at home as well, which is lovely for the staff to see. If you have not activated your account please let us know, and we will try to sort any problems out for you.

School fund

We rely heavily on your generosity giving money for school fund. We use this to buy snacks; top up the cost of any trips and to buy extras that our budget does not cover e.g. shaving foam; cornflour and play dough. We spend over £60 per week on snacks if everyone donated £5 we would have £600 each half term, we are lucky if we get £100. It is easy to pay school fund through Parent pay, and you can also use the barcode at the co-op to pay that way. Please see April for any further information.

- As the weather is warming up, we will be playing with more water. Please ensure your child has a few changes of clothes each day.
- Please do not send your child to school in flip flops or sliders. These are dangerous when they run around. Please make sure that sandals have a back to them.
- If your child is off school for any reason, then please contact the school office. 020 8311 0619 or send an email to April. Royal Greenwich and OFSTED expect children to be attending 94% of the time. We need to be able to tell them that we know the reasons for any absences.

• Nappies

If your child is in nappies please ensure that they have a supply to change them in each session. We do not have any spare ones in school and will need to call you to bring some in if your child needs changing. If you would like any help with toilet training please talk to the class.

We would like to wish all our Muslim families, **EID Mubarak** as they celebrate **EID AL**-**FITR** the end of their fasting for Ramadan, which will be at the end of this week. We hope that our Christian families enjoyed the **Easter break**.
