It remains very important that if you, your child or anyone in your family has symptoms that you self-isolate according to the Government guidelines. Please inform us if you are doing this. It is also important that you inform us as soon as possible if you or your family has a positive test.

We know that the staggered times have made life challenging for some of you who have children at other schools. We will not be able to meet everyone's needs, however, after discussion with the staff and looking at the present system we are going to make these changes from Monday 5<sup>th</sup> October. We have painted RED LINES across each class room entrance. Please do not cross it unless you are settling a child.

Morning session children to arrive between 9.00- 9.15.

Morning children leave between 11.15 -11.30.

Afternoon children arrive between 12,30-12,45

All children go home between 2.45 -3.00

It is very important that the children are picked up by 3pm. Staff need to clean and to prepare for the next day. If your circumstances have changed and you might now be entitled to free school meals, then please contact us. We are happy to try and support you with any application. If you are struggling to cope, then please contact us. We can link you to the right places for support. Gill can also request that you

receive a food box.

## A few reminders: Please make sure that your child's name is in their coat. Applications for primary schools is now open. You need to apply on line. You need to name up to 6 schools. Please contact Gill if you would like any help. The closing date is 15th January 2020. • Please do not use your phone anywhere on the school site.
