

Other sound ideas

- Try coming up with your own short animal sentences like in the story 'Animal Music' with both words starting with the same sound. Look at some examples from the book as reference eg 'turtles toot' 'badger bashes'
- Do a performance of a new song you have learnt! Invite your family to come and watch you perform. Maybe you could draw or make invitations?
- Did you know you can make lots of sounds with your body? Try and find out how many you can make! Maybe you can make a rhythm using different parts of yourself? Does it sound different if you clap your hands onto your thighs or onto your head? How can you make sounds with your elbows or your feet?
- Pick up keys game - take it in turns to pick up a set of keys from the table or floor and pass them to somebody else without making a noise. It's very tricky! If the keys make a sound then put them down and let the next person have a turn.
- Make sounds in the bath - try using different objects eg sieves, bottles, tubes, spoons, whisks etc to find out the different splashy splashy noises you can make. Are the sounds different when the water is more bubbly?
