

Activities to do at home with your child:

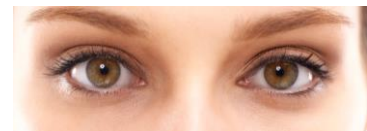
1. Look for objects around your home that have different patterns. Objects with spots or stripes? Can you draw the objects you find?

3. How many odd socks can you find in your house?
4. How tall are you if you measure yourself with socks? Lay on the floor and line the socks up next to you, how many does it take to reach from your head to your toes?



5. What can you find in your house that also comes in a pair?



6. How many pairs can you find across your home?
7. Ask your grown up to hide your favourite pair of socks and see if you can find them
8. Make a sock puppet! Use an old sock and glue or sew its face on. You can use buttons, ribbon, paper, anything you have at home! Put it on your hand to move its mouth.



9. Can you tell a grown up a story using your sock puppet?
