As the children start school, we will be focussing on their physical development. This is a prime area of the EYFS. We will be doing lots of outdoor activities like climbing, games and making big movements. This strengthens the children's gross motor skills.

We will also be working on the children's fine motor skills to strengthen their muscles in their hands and fingers, supporting them to hold a pencil and a pair of scissors correctly.

This half term, our topic is 'All about me'. We will be talking about families, ourselves and how we are similar and different to others. This topic supports the children settling into the school environment and promotes their PSED development.
