English. In English, the children will be learning to apply a range of grammar features in their writing through a selection of stimuli.

Beginning with writing a dialogue, children will choose a historical figure to research before applying this to a question-and-answer scenario. Following this, we will focus on diary writing, where children will apply their knowledge of informal language.

History This term, the children will be learning about migration. Working as historians, the children will ask questions about what migration is and why it happens. They will develop an understanding of movement throughout history, specifically, building on their knowledge of WWII, the Windrush Generation.

Geography Children will learn about biome across the world, including how plants, animals and climates change depending on their location. We will compare different biomes and consider the challenges in each.
