

School Meal Feedback - Thank You!

Thank you to all parents and carers who completed our school meal feedback form. We were delighted that the responses were overwhelmingly positive.

After reviewing all feedback carefully, here are the key areas we are continuing to strengthen:

Encouraging children to try new foods. We know that some children can be hesitant with unfamiliar dishes. To support this, we will continue offering small tasting portions and creating a positive, calm environment where children feel confident to give new foods a go, when we change the menu. Just as we did at parent consultations in October. We received lots of encouraging comments and truly appreciate your support.

Jacket potato toppings Toppings are provided on a rotation of beans and tuna, with cheese available every day.

Portion sizes Portion sizes do vary by year group. For example, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive two fish fingers, while Years 3-6 receive three. Children are always welcome to ask for additional vegetables, and we are happy to provide more to support a balanced diet.

Menu variety We are pleased to offer a three-week rolling menu with three options each day, ensuring good variety over the course of the term.

Cold meal option We are exploring the introduction of a cold meal option from late spring into the summer months. During autumn and winter, we will continue encouraging pupils to choose a hot meal.

Hygiene standards Our catering team maintains excellent hygiene practices, and we are proud to have achieved a top rating of 5 stars in our recent unannounced food safety inspection. Staff follow strict hygiene procedures, including wearing gloves when handling food.

Thank you again for your thoughtful feedback. We remain committed to providing healthy, enjoyable meals for all children.
