English In English, the children will be learning to apply a range of grammar features in their writing through a selection of texts. Grammar is taught daily, alongside handwriting and spellings, which children are encouraged to practise regularly.

This term, our book is, 'Letters from the Lighthouse' by Emma Carroll, a thought-provoking book which supports children's learning in history. Throughout the term, we will be writing for a range of audiences, including a description, narratives, letter writing, balanced arguments and nonfiction.

## Other Topics this term

History This term, the children will be learning about World War II. Working as historians, the children will ask questions about how WWII began, evacuation, The Blitz Winston Churchill and how life changed during the war.

Geography The children will be learning about Rivers, including the revision of the water cycle.

The unit will cover the features of a river and field work focused on the River Stort.
