

English

In English this term we will be reading 'The Lion Inside' by Rachel Bright and the exploring the key features of a 'wishing tale'. The children will continue to develop their writing skills and begin to build on the foundations they have built in year 1. We will also be studying this text in our reading lessons where the children will discuss the text to develop their reading comprehension.

As well as this, children will have daily phonics lessons, handwriting sessions, grammar and spelling sessions.

Other Topics this term

In History this term, we will be exploring our local history and looking at Harlow over time, as well as our school's history. Children will learn to analyse historic artefacts to help them gain an understanding of the past.

In Science we will continue our work on looking at the seasons and what we can expect to see, hear and feel at different times of the year. As well as this, we will look at what causes the seasons to shift.
