They have done two reading papers and two maths papers, with just Grammar and Spelling to complete on Monday. Mrs Shaw and Mrs Jennings have been so proud of them all week and have commented on how mature and confident the children have been throughout, not getting upset or stressed and just getting on with doing their best and completing all the questions.

Well done Year 2 – we are all so proud of you!

We now await grade boundaries for these tests being published online so we can convert their results in Standardised Scores and combine these with evidence shown in their books to come up with an overall Teacher Assessment Judgement, which will be shared with you on their end of year reports in July.

Next month, Year 1 will undergo the Phonics Screening Test and Year 4 will take the new Multiplication Test Check. Both Year groups are fully prepared for these and I know the children will smash them!
