### Message from Mrs Crossley

**E-Safety:** This week we welcomed 'D-Side Dave' back in to school to deliver internet safety lessons to all classes throughout school. These sessions are extremely important in delivering key safety messages to our children about how to remain safe on line. Class 1 and 2 focused on: what we use the internet for; what is safe/not safe to share online and what to do if they are not sure about the internet. Class 3 and 4 discussed: ways to use emails safely; social networking and safe profiling (including the use of Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Snap Chat and Tik Tok etc); how to use 'chat' facilities appropriately and with care; responsible and safe use of the internet and using texts and picture messages appropriately. Our older children were also reminded about the minimum age limits for various social media sites.

In addition to this, Mrs Sanpher, our Computing lead in school, has remapped the curriculum to ensure internet safety sessions feature in each computing unit throughout the year to enable us to maintain the high profile of these crucial messages to our children.

Please continue to support our work in school by remaining vigilant at home with your child/ren when they are accessing online sites/social media/messaging facilities to ensure they are keeping safe.
