Our Collective Worship theme this half term has been perseverance and we have spent a lot of time thinking about all the different ways in which we persevere. Our children have been reflective about this particular Christian Value and have looked at different ways in which we can persevere, rather than just looking at it as keeping going and shared observations such as being focused on one task until the end, rather than doing bits of several things at the same time.
