### Message from Mrs Crossley

#### Sports day

We have set dates for Sporting activities to be held in school in the final week of term, in the place of our traditional sports day. These will take place on our school field. To keep groups small and to minimise bubbles mixing, we have planned a separate event for each key stage:

- KS1 Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> 9:30 – 11:30am
- KS2 Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> 9:30 – 11:30am

The events will consist of a carousel of athletic based skills, done in small groups. Parents are welcome to join us to watch the events, with a few Covid related precautions in place.

- Family groups must stay within the designated areas and not mix with the school children.
- All spectators may only gather outside in groups of up to 30 and must stay 2 metres away from any other groups.
- Refreshments will not be available so please do feel free to bring your own.
- Toilet facilities will not be available to any spectators.
- Social distancing must be observed when entering and leaving the school grounds via the gate.
- As per any event in school, please try to only photograph your own child and do not share any photographs on social media that contain other children. Some of our children must not have their image posted online and we ask all parents to respect our safeguarding policy with regards to this.

#### Covid test

If your child has any symptoms of Coronavirus, they need to book in for a PCR test. Home Lateral flow tests are only for regular symptomless testing. More information regarding this can be found on the .Gov or NHS website.

From September, our school must be a Nut Free School at all times. One of our new reception class starters has a severe peanut allergy and may suffer severe anaphylaxis if they come into contact with even traces of nut. Our school kitchen has been nut free for many years but we now need to ask parents to ensure all packed lunches and snacks coming into school from September do not contain peanuts. Whilst we appreciate that this is an extra thing to have to check, we are sure you appreciate that allergic reactions to peanuts can be severe and life threatening.

We are currently auditing all of our reading books with the view to replenish and enhance our stock before the end of term. Please could you send ALL school reading books and library books back in to school **no later than Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July** for us to complete our records.
