#### **World Book Day Celebrations**



He's a children's author of the Milkman Mike series, which he brought in to share with the children. He also writes adult fiction (crime thrillers) that parents and guardians may like and for The Yorkshire Post every Saturday about farming and the countryside. He is also commissioned to write autobiographies.

We are hoping to work together as part of a new and exciting Aberford Literature Festival and hope to start Aberford Junior Authors as part of the festival.
