Fingers crossed for some dry days during half term and we will see you all back on Monday 23rd February!

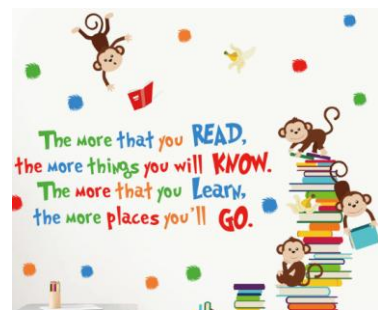
World Book Day
