Coming to school on time

Our school day starts at 8:45 when the bell goes to line up. The children in every class then have registration time in class between 8:45 and 9:00, before Collective Worship starts in the hall at 9:00. Registration time is a hugely important time of the day for children and for class teachers for many reasons. It is the time when the online registers are completed, the dinner registers are completed and any letters or slips are handed in. Children then all complete a consolidation task quietly. This helps the children settle for the day and gives teachers the opportunity to check in with any pupils who may need a friendly word before their day starts.

At the moment, we have far too many pupils arriving late for school, which means that this registration time is regularly disrupted in every class. This can also lead to orders for dinners being missed when children arrive after the order has been submitted.

We fully understand that sometimes, mornings can be hectic and that we can all, on occasion, be later than we planned. We are sensitive to this when it happens and make sure the children are welcomed into school and helped to settle. However, too many children are regularly arriving late and we need to work together to ensure this trend is reversed.
