Wider Reopening

You will be aware from recent government announcements that schools can return more pupils where they have capacity to do so. It had been suggested that some children from Years 2, 3, 4 and 5 could return before the summer holidays. As I am sure you understand, capacity is an individual situation for all schools and depends on physical space and numbers of staff available. Because of the guidance that bubble sizes be a maximum of 15, taking into account the dimensions of the building and the number of full staff available, our original reopening plan identified our maximum number of places available as 45. Our position from next week is as follows:

- The Reception / Year 1 bubble is at full capacity.
- The Key Worker bubble has 4 spaces, which will be allocated following the Government Guidance.
- The Year 6 bubble is at full capacity.
- All available staff are allocated to bubbles with no capacity to set up any new bubbles at this time.

Given all of the above, it is not possible for us to return any more year groups before the summer break. I do appreciate that this solution is far from ideal and we are all feeling for our children in Years 2, 3, 4 and 5 who are unable to return. As a school we will continue to work towards a return for all children as soon as the Government Guidance allows this. I am so grateful to parents for the kindness and understanding towards our staff that has been so prevalent during this pandemic. We continue to wish everyone well and look forward to the day when we can welcome our whole community back into school.
