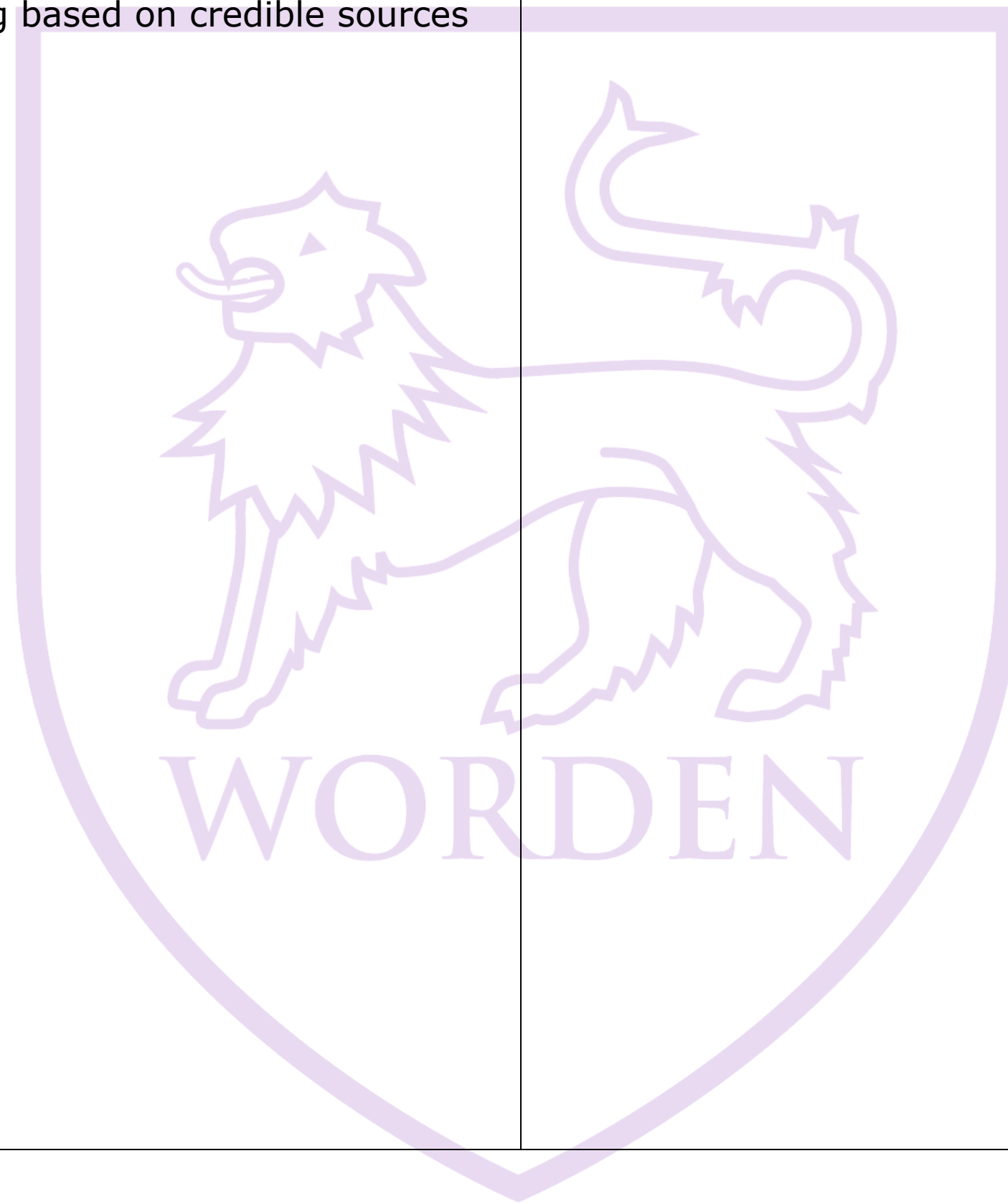
Topic 1
