Full Governing Body Tuesday April 2nd, 2019

At our meeting we co-opted a new Governor. Pav Akhtar lives in Fulwood and grew up in Preston before living in other parts of this country and the world. He has been a school governor previously and we welcome what his wide knowledge and experience will bring to Acorns Governing Body.

Governors gave approval to the Headteacher and staff to organise 3 residential experiences. These will give pupils the wonderful opportunity to be involved in all sorts of different activities – including being away from home! The centres that are used by Acorns are designed to meet the needs at all abilities and children love going!

Governors are linked to class groups and visit these classes to learn about what goes on. This knowledge helps them to make decisions which they know will be right for our pupils. At our meeting we listened to reports from individual governors – all had nothing but praise for both staff and pupils. They also committed to ensure they completed further visits in the summer term.

As part of the meeting Governors listened to a presentation on staff well-being. All our staff work incredibly hard and sometimes must cope with some very challenging situations. Governors committed the Governing Body to ensuring that staff feel supported in and appreciated for the work they do.
