In science, we have been learning about light. Some of the children went on a 'light hunt' in school, and others explored and learned about transparent, translucent, and opaque materials.

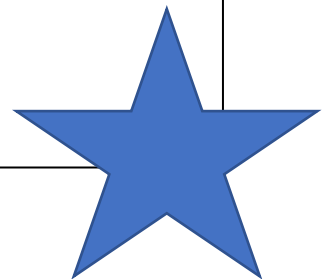
In English we have been reading, writing, and performing Christmas poems. The children loved signing and doing actions along to the words.

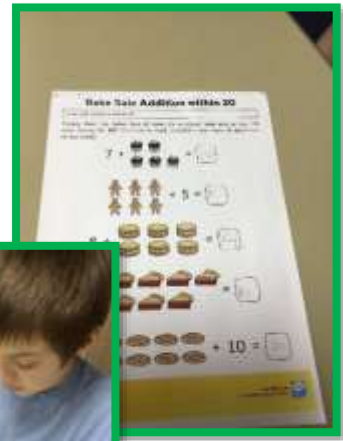

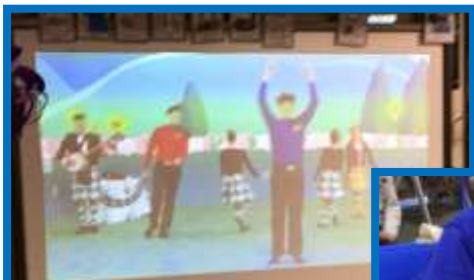
