Dear Parents/Carers,

Unfortunately we have had a case of COVID in school and had to close a bubble. We do not want to be in the same situation we were in during the Spring term with many staff and children ill with COVID. Please can I urge you to be vigilant and not send children into school if they, or any family member are ill. Please also do a PCR test to rule out COVID. I understand this means keeping children at home and after the disrupted year they have had this is really difficult. However, we want to limit any spread in school.

Look out for:

- Temperatures.
- Stomach ache, vomiting or diarrhoea.
- A continuous prolonged cough.
- Loss of taste and smell.

Also keep an eye out for unusual changes in behaviour or children generally seeming unwell.

The actions we will continue to take in school are:

- We will be continuing testing staff twice weekly.
- Using the viracube to deep clean classes on a rota.
- Wearing masks.
- Staying within bubbles.
- Practising excellent hand hygiene.
- Maintaining social distancing.

Please continue to support us and together we can limit the spread in our school.
