Oak Class News

It has been a lovely half term in Oak Class so far. Our topic this term is 'Bright Sparks' and the children have been doing lots of exciting work and activities. Here are a few of the things that we have been doing:

- We have been reading different fiction and non-fiction texts linked to light and electricity. The children enjoyed listening to the stories and doing lots of work based on the characters, plots and settings.
- In **My Thinking and Learning**, we have been working hard on place value. The children have been adding hundreds, tens and ones. Then partitioning 2 and 3 digit numbers. They have also been learning to recall their number bonds to 10 and 20.
- Part of our My World work has been learning about light. They have identified different sources of light, have learnt about opaque, translucent and transparent materials and have been learning about how shadows are created.
- My Creativity lessons have been great!. The children have been inspired and have engaged really well. They have been learning about Van Gogh and doing art work in the style of his painting A Starry Night. They have also designed and made their own rockets and made their own owls.
- It has been great to see our children practising their functional skills and learning more about the world on trips to Sainsbury's.
- In PE, we have been practising our gymnastics skills. We have been balancing on different parts of the body and learning how to travel in different ways on the floor and on different apparatus.
