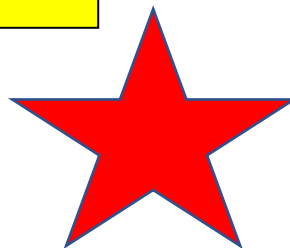
- We have been exploring the March of the Lion, thinking about the sound Lions make and the music from the Carnival of the Animals.
