Sensory – SPACE session £80 June 2020	Provide our sensory learners with opportunities to develop their physical skills away from the school and with specialised resources and equipment
Pine Class: Balance track Rocker – sensory Weighted vest Artificial grass mat £250	Weighted vest for pupils to help regulate their sensory system in order to learn. Sensory resources for vestibular and proprioception input Improved focus and progress noted
Vestibular/ Sensory resources: Spinning seat Balance beam Therapy balls Resistance bands x 3 Spinning/balance board £300	These resources are used to provide pupils with a sensory diet to help regulate their sensory systems. Many pupils seek physical movement and therefore require opportunities to meet these needs in a safe and appropriate way. These resources are used daily with lot of pupils. Impact – improving focus and concentration in the classroom & providing sensory input
Sensory PE Curriculum – Re-stock resources	Used by all our sensory learners throughout school – managed and maintained by C. Campbell (liaise regularly with S. Martindale in regards to this) Nothing has needed to be replenished this year
Fine motor resources for KS1 & Pine Peacocks Funky fish Worm Connect owls Alphabet alligators Scoops (scissors) Fine motor set £186	These resources are extremely well used throughout early years and KS1. The pupils are developing their fine motor skills through regular practice Pupils need to improve strength, co ordination, dexterity and accessing this type of activity provides the support needed to improve life skills, writing and independence in the future
Rugby – sessions Autumn term £540	Pupils experience a sport delivered by an external provider.
