What is the Sports Premium?

The funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see the money going directly to the primary school to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children.

The money can only be spent on sport and PE provision in school.

Purpose of the Funding

Schools will have to spend their allocated sports funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this. At Acorns Primary School, we recognise the contribution of PE to the health and well-being of all the children.
