Dear Parents/ Carers,

Please be aware that cases of COVID-19 are still emerging across the Preston area and rising in parts of the North West. Pupils should still be kept at home and receive a COVID test if they have any of the following symptoms.

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss or change to their sense of smell or taste.

If a family member is displaying symptoms, please make sure they receive a negative COVID test result before sending your child back to school.

Please look out for any other symptoms which may be linked to COVID as we all need to be extra vigilant. If in doubt, please get a test.

Please also keep pupils at home if they are ill with anything which means they are not well enough to partake in normal school activities. If we do ask you to keep your child off or ring you to collect them, please know the decision has not been taken lightly.

If your child has a bout of vomiting or diarrhoea, they will need to remain at home for 2 days following their last bout.

If your child is required to take a course of antibiotics, they will need to remain at home until they have completed half of the course, as per our administering medications policy.
