

## This week...

This week our focus has been on the story book 'The Hungry Caterpillar' the children have really enjoyed this story. It is a nice story to share at home too.

We have been making caterpillars and butterflies.

The children participated in a fruit tasting session this week - we talked about the flavours and colours of the fruit and how the caterpillar ate them in the story. We then made fruit kebabs.

Some of the children are having sessions with the eye gaze which allows the children to interact using their eyes to select items on the iPad. These sessions are working well for the pupils involved.

Our phonics and literacy session was very positive this week. The children are developing their understanding of letter sounds and their early reading skills. We have been working on initial sounds of objects and pictures and building cvc words.

We will be continuing our bugs and buds topic - continuing our learning about mini beasts and starting to learn about plants.
