

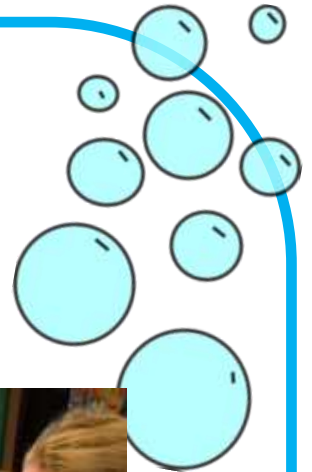
# Seedlings Weekly News

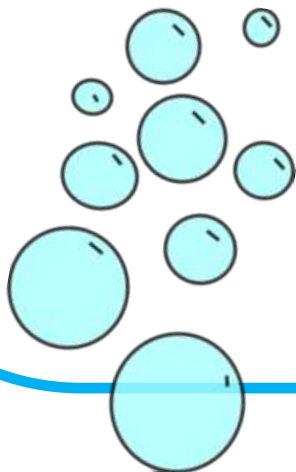
## This week...

This week our focus sea creature has been crabs. We have looked at pictures of crabs and talked about what they look like. We counted their legs and how many claws that they have.

We regularly work on tasks and activities that help to develop fine motor skills and coordination. Scissor skills are a great way to support this and also help to improve the children's motivation and concentration. The children were supported to use the scissor block or the loop scissors to snip along the lines to make the crab's legs.



This week we also enjoyed a session in the forest school and outdoor trampoline area. The children were able to explore the areas. They liked playing at the mud kitchen and rolling the balls down the guttering.

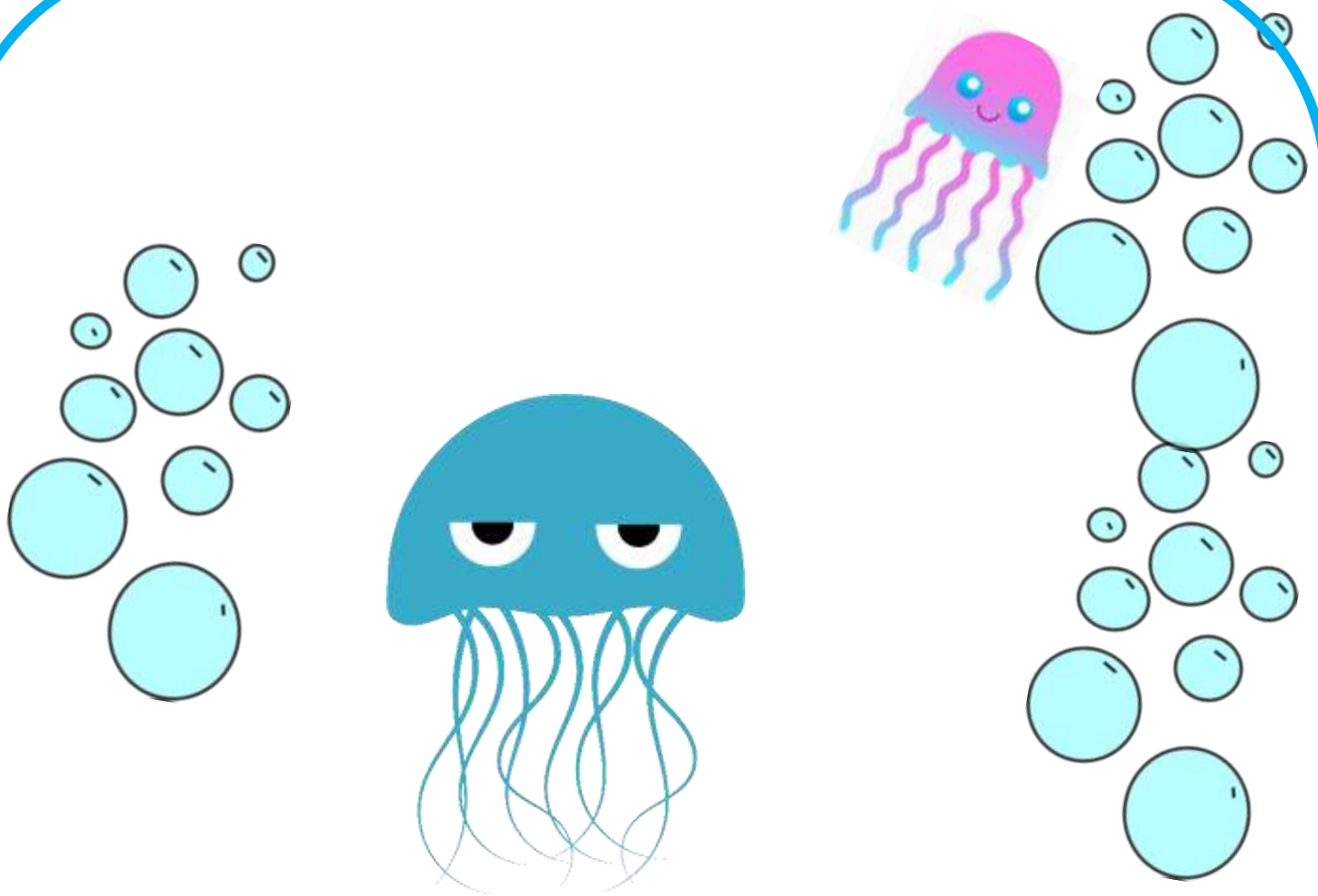
