In **My Communication and Interaction** we have been reading the story of **Zog** by Julia Donaldson. We have been exploring associated items, answering questions, and ordering events in the story.

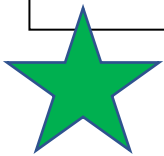
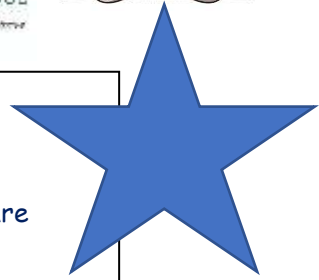

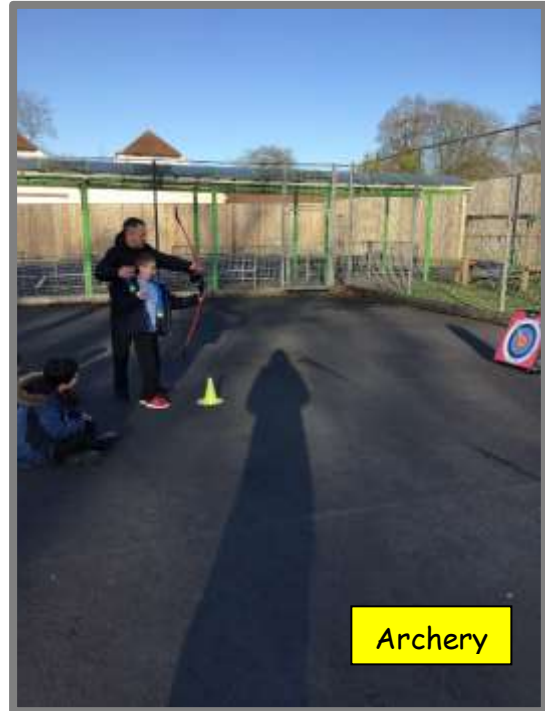
