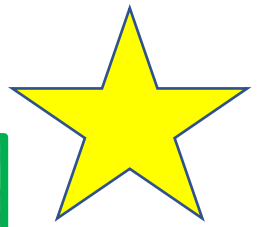

He took the opportunity to join the music session when he came back from food tech. He played the glockenspiel really well!

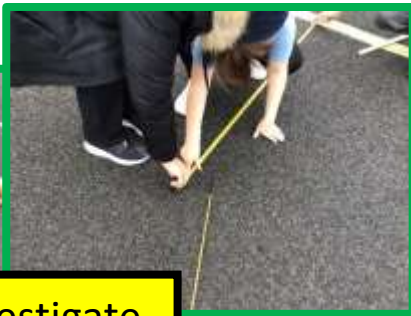
