Wed/ Thurs groups made some brilliant leaning towers of Pisa in Geography and read the Roman numerals, making a clock, in History.

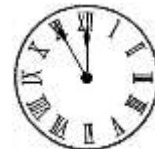
Both groups have worked hard with problem solving in maths and reading our story of Little Babaji in English, there was some fabulous role play of the story!
