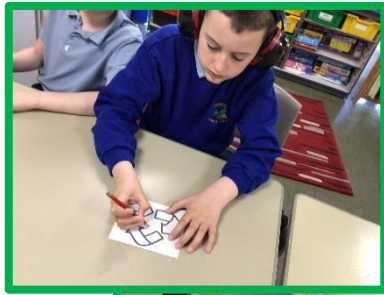

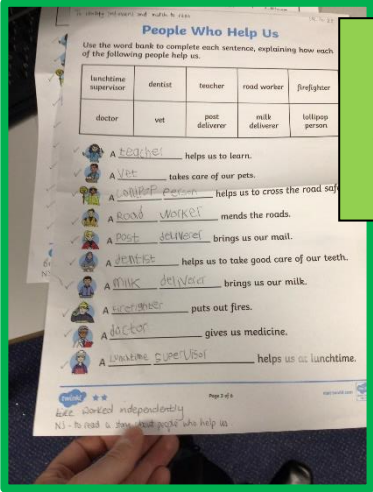
Star of the Week

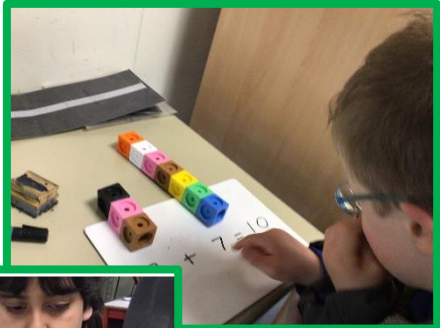
