

This week...

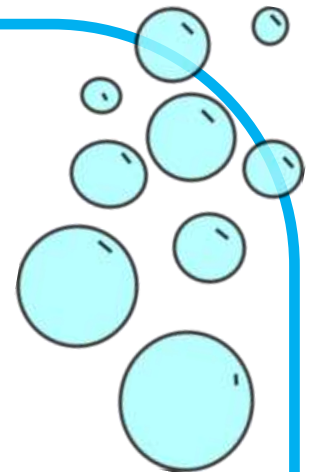
Our learning has focused on jelly fish, which we discovered should be called sea jellies.

The children have made some beautiful crafts, focusing on gluing and sticking, early scissors skills and continuing to develop out painting skills.



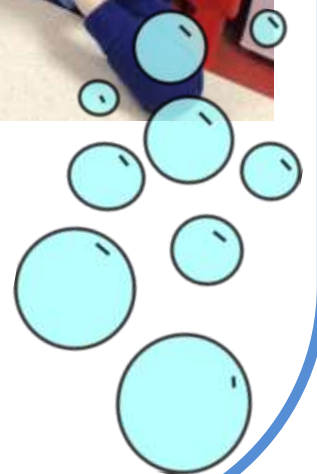
We learnt the makaton sign for jellyfish. This is the link if you want to practise at home.

In messy play with explored jelly with our hands and spoons.

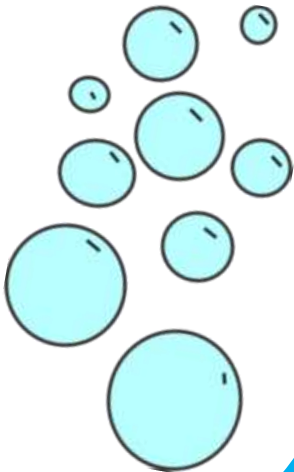
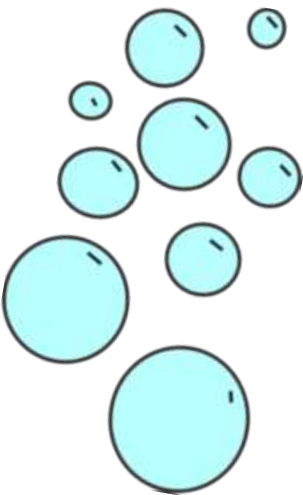
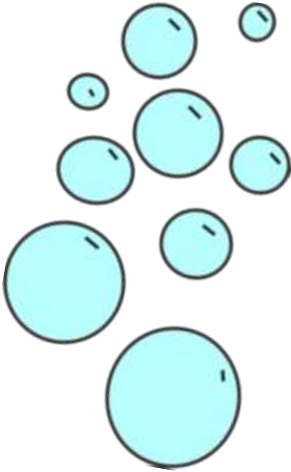


Last Friday we made some clay starfish, which we have now painted and decorated.
