Snack, cooking and sensory play money is <u>£2 per week</u>. Please remember to send this in weekly as it pays for the food and resources we use every day!


Also with the weather getting warmer please can you please make sure that the children are dressed appropriately and that you apply and send in sun cream so that we can keep everyone safe from the sun ©


