We have not got as many photos as we would normally have as we are down to one ipad at the moment while the other is fixed and I have been using it for reviews this week.

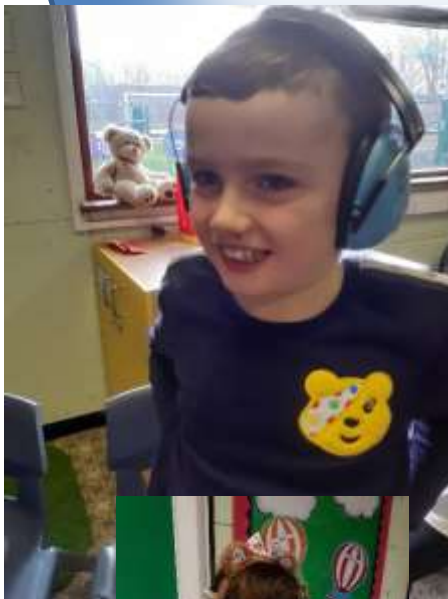
On Monday we did a lovely Remembrance Day themed phonics session – P for poppies and S for soldiers – we dressed some of the children up as soldiers and talking about how we remember all those brave ones who fought long time ago in the war. In our science this week we started a new topic of 'light' we explored lots of different light up objects and turn the lights out to see what would happen with no light – it was very dark!

We also started our new class stories sensory story is The Gingerbread Man -O the children really enjoyed exploring all the props. The other story is Can't you sleep little bear? which ties in nicely with our Science focus. We made night time pictures using blue paint for our display.
