Messy Pumpkin Play - we enjoyed scooping out and playing with the pumpkins

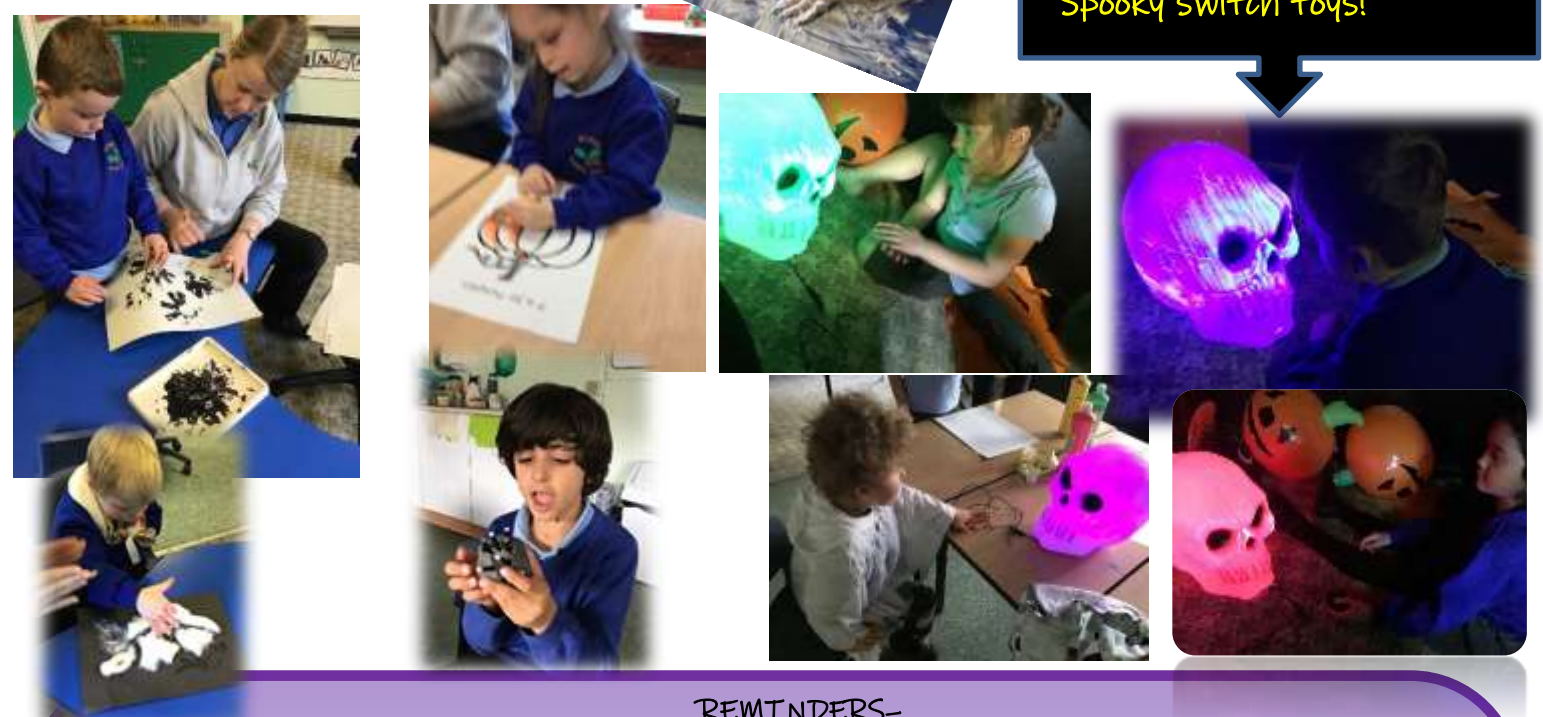

Plus lots more- we hope the pictures do it justice

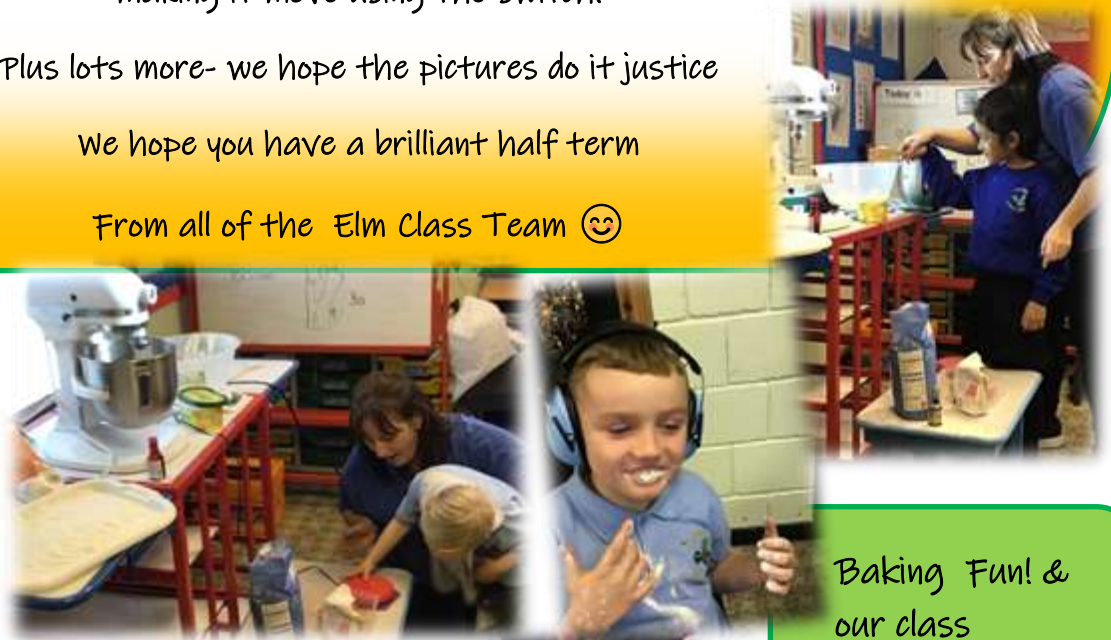
