Our caterpillars are getting very big - we see how they have grown each day!

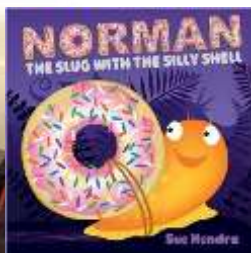
