

Uniform

From September 2026, secondary schools are limited to four branded uniform items, including the tie. These items must be purchased from approved uniform suppliers and display the school logo. All other uniform items should be available from a range of retailers, allowing parents to choose lower-cost options.

Parents/Carers should ensure that each item of school uniform, kit and equipment is clearly labelled with the student's name and tutor group

Blazer Teal with embroidered Ada Lovelace school crest	A compulsory branded item	
Tie Silver and teal stripe	A compulsory branded item	
Shirt Plain white, long or short sleeved	Shirts must be sufficiently generous to tuck fully into trousers. Collars must be large enough to button up fully. Pupils will be asked to replace missing buttons.	
Trousers/Skirts - Grey school trousers - Pleated teal tartan skirt	Trousers Grey tailored design in non-stretch fabric Skirt Skirts must not be rolled up, and must sit 'on the knee', and not higher. If students choose to wear a skirt it must be the pleated teal tartan skirt. Students who are unable to wear their skirt in line with our expectations will be asked to wear trousers.	
Pullover Grey v-neck	The pullover is optional. Cardigans and vests are not to be worn.	
Socks / Tights - White ankle socks OR (not both) - Plain black tights	No 'leg warmers' or knee socks. No branded socks are allowed including sports socks with stripes or ticks.	
Shoes - Black (upper and sole) - Smart, plain and polishable.	Trainer-style shoes or canvas style footwear are not appropriate as formal school footwear and therefore not allowed. Shoes must be worn to and from school.	
Coat Plain black or navy	Coats are not permitted to be worn in the building. Gilets, body-warmers & fur trims are not permitted.	
School Scarf & Hat - Plain black or navy scarf - Plain black or navy beanie hat	Snoods, baseball caps and other hats are not permitted.	
Official School Bag Black backpack with embroidered Ada Lovelace school crest	A compulsory branded item	
Hair - Hair bands, ribbons, clips and any other item used in the hair should be plain black, white or teal. - Head scarves or other head/hair coverings worn for religious reasons should be plain black, white or teal.	Dyed hair and hair extensions should be a natural colour. Two-tone hair and undercuts are not permitted.	
Jewellery - One small plain stud earring may be worn in each ear lobe. - Rings, necklaces, bracelets etc. should not be worn	Students who come to school with piercings outside of our policy will be asked to remove them. Excuses that piercings cannot be taken out because they are freshly done will not be accepted. Jewellery will be confiscated if worn to school.	
Make-up And Nail Varnish Must not be worn	Students will be asked to remove all make-up including fake eye-lashes. Gel and acrylic nails are not permitted.

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Trousers Grey school trousers	A tailored design in non-stretch fabric. Shirts must be tucked in at all times and trousers worn above the hip.	
Pullover/Jumper Grey V-neck	The pullover is an optional item. Cardigans and vests are not to be worn.	
Socks Plain black or grey ankle socks	No coloured or patterned socks of any kind are allowed.	
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
