

We are writing to introduce our School Fund to you. This is a fund operated in all Trust Schools and the Ada Lovelace Governing Body will manage it to fund projects over and above what would otherwise be possible.

Our School Fund is built up from financial donations from parents/carers and is held in a separate bank account to other funding. It has a very important function which helps pay for additional facilities and development projects.

Use of the School Fund will be decided by the Governing Body in consultation with the Parents and Teachers Association (the PTA), of which you are all members. The fund-raising aim of the PTA is to support our departments in school with purchasing of equipment and resources. The School Fund part or fully funds larger, more long-term investments in the fabric of the school,

The money raised by the School Fund so far has already funded the Ada Lovelace themed sculpture for the playground to inspire the pupils and create our Ada Lovelace identity, as well as the stone benches for two areas in the playground. It has also provided the capital funding for the school garden.





In 2023/4 it funded the amazing new artwork in the new School Chapel and will help ensure the new Inclusion room that is being fitted out over the summer holidays will be as welcoming as possible for our students.
